

## SUMMARY OF THE PROPOSED COMBINATION

*[in terms of Regulation 13(1B) of the Competition Commission of India  
(Procedure in regard to the transaction of business relating to combinations)  
Regulations, 2011, as amended]*

### **A. Name of the Parties**

1. The Parties to the combination are:
  - (a) China National Agrochemical Corporation (“**CNAC**”);
  - (b) Syngenta AG (“**Syngenta**”).

### **B. Type of the Combination**

2. The proposed transaction relates to the acquisition of shares and indirect sole control of Syngenta by China National Chemical Corporation (“**ChemChina**”), through its subsidiary CNAC (the “**Proposed Transaction**”). The Proposed Transaction amounts to a combination in terms of Section 5 (a) (i) (B) of the Competition Act, 2002.

### **C. Area of Activity of the Parties to the combination**

3. CNAC is the agrochemical division of ChemChina which manufactures and sells generic active ingredients and formulated products used for crop protection and, to a lesser extent, non-agrochemical crop products for home and garden and pest control operations.
4. Syngenta is active on a global basis operating in the crop protection and seeds business. It is involved in the research, development, manufacture and marketing of agrochemical products (formulated products used for crop protection and chemical fertilizers and, to a lesser extent, active ingredients

sold on a standalone basis), and in the lawn and garden business (flowers, turf and landscape, and professional pest management products).

**D. Relevant Market**

5. Market for formulated products in India.

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
