Summary of the Combination

[In terms of Regulation 13 (1B) of the Competition Commission of India (Procedure in regard to the transaction of business relating to combinations), 2011]

A. Name of the Parties to the combination

Vodafone India Limited (VIL), Vodafone Mobile Services Limited (VMSL)
(collectively, Vodafone India) and Idea Cellular Limited (Idea).

B. Type of the combination

2. The proposed transaction relates to the proposed merger of the telecommunications businesses of Vodafone India and Idea (the *Proposed Transaction*). By way of the Proposed Transaction, Vodafone India and Idea seek to combine their telecommunications businesses in India by way of a scheme of amalgamation and arrangement under Sections 230 to 232 of the Companies Act, 2013 (*Companies Act*).

C. Area of activity of the Parties to the combination

Vodafone India

3. VIL is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Vodafone Group Plc, which is listed on the London Stock Exchange. VMSL is a wholly owned subsidiary of VIL. Together, VIL and VMSL (i.e. Vodafone India) are a pan-India integrated mobile operator offering telecommunication services, including pan-India mobile telephony services across all 22 telecom circles, servicing about more than 200 million subscribers across India as of December 2016.

Idea

4. Idea is a pan-Indian integrated mobile operator offering telecommunication services. Idea provides pan-India mobile telephony services across 22 telecom circles servicing about 200 million subscribers across India. Idea is listed on the National Stock Exchange and Bombay Stock Exchange.

D. Relevant market(s) to which the combination relates

- 5. The Parties are national telecom service providers and provide similar services across a number of service areas.
- 6. In particular, the following services of the Parties are in the same relevant market(s):
 - a. Mobile telephony services in each circle
 - b. Enterprise services;
 - c. Internet Service Provider (ISP) services;
 - d. Intra-circle roaming services;
 - e. International long distance (*ILD*) services;
 - f. National long distance (*NLD*) services;
 - g. Provision of passive infrastructure services through telecom towers;
 - h. Provision of passive infrastructure services over fiber optic network; and
 - i. Mobile wallet services.
