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INTRODUCTION

The Competition Act 2002 (No. 12 of 2003) came into existence in October 2003 and was comprehensively amended by the Competition (Amendment) Act, 2007. As per Section 51 of the Competition Act 2002, a fund called "Competition Fund" has been constituted on 1st May 2009. Prior to this the expenses of the Commission were being funded through regular budget system and bills were drawn from the Consolidated Fund of India through Pay & Accounts office of the Ministry of Corporate Affairs from 14th October 2003 to 30th April 2009. The Government of India, Ministry of Corporate Affairs sanctions Grant-in-aid with effect from 1st May 2009, which have been deposited into the "Competition Fund". The fund is being utilised for meeting the salaries & allowances, administrative expenses and other office expenses of the Commission for carrying out the objects for which the fund has been constituted under Section 51 of the Act. The Government of India, Ministry of Corporate Affairs vide gazette notification No. G.S.R 204 (A) dated 27th March 2009 framed the Competition Commission of India (Form of Annual Statement of Accounts) Rules, 2009.

The Accounts of the Commission have been prepared in the "Form of Financial Statements" prescribed by the Government of India vide notification dated 27th March 2009. The Annual Accounts prepared by the Commission have been audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.



Separate Audit Report of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India on the Accounts of Competition Commission of India (CCI) for the year ended 31 March 2017

- 1. We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of Competition Commission of India (CCI) as at 31 March 2017 and the Income & Expenditure Account/Receipt & Payment Account for the year ended on that date under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller & Auditor General's (Duties, Power & Conditions of Service) Act,1971 read with Section 52(2) of Competition Act, 2002. These financial statements are the responsibility of CCI. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.
- This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India (C&AG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms etc. Audit observations on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the Laws, Rules & Regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects etc., if any, are reported through Inspection Reports/CAG's Audit Report separately.
- 3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidences supporting the amount and disclosure in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.
- 4. Based on our audit, we report that:
 - i) We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit.
 - ii) The Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account/Receipt & Payment Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the format of Accounts approved by Ministry of Finance under Rule 3 & 5 of Competition Commission of India (Form of Annual Statement of Accounts) Rules, 2009.
 - iii) In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by CCI in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.
 - iv) We further report that:



A. Significant Accounting Policies(Schedule XXII)

Policy No. 5 Government Grants/Subsidies

As per Rule 3 of Competition Commission of India (Form of Annual Statement of Accounts) Rules, 2009, Government Grants/Subsidies of the nature of contribution towards capital cost of setting up projects are treated as Capital Reserve. The Rule 3 further provided that Grants in respect of specific fixed assets acquired are shown as a deduction from the cost of the related assets. The accounting policy No. 5 of CCI, however, did not disclose the accounting policies as per the provisions of Competition Commission of India (Form of Annual Statement of Accounts) Rules, 2009. This issue was raised during 2015-16 also, however, no corrective action has been taken yet.

B. Grants-in-aid

During the year 2016-17, CCI received a total grant of Rs. 92.10 crore from the Ministry of Corporate Affairs out of which it could utilize Rs. 89.25 crore during 2016-17, leaving an unspent balance of Rs. 2.85 crore.

C. Management Letter

Deficiency, which have not been included in the Separate Audit Report, have been brought to the notice of the Chairman of CCI through a management letter issued separately for remedial/corrective action.

- v) Subject to our observations in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance Sheet and Income & Expenditure Account/ Receipt & Payment Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of account.
- vi) In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the said financial statements read together with the Accounting Policies and Notes on Accounts, subject to significant matters stated above and other matters mentioned in Annexure to this Separate Audit Report, give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India.
 - a) In so far as it relates to the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of Competition Commission of India as at 31 March 2017; and
 - b) In so far as it relates Income & Expenditure Account of the surplus for the year ended on that date.

SCHEDULE - XXII

SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. ACCOUNTING CONVENTION

- 1.1 The Financial Statements are prepared on the basis of historical cost convention and on the accrual method of accounting unless stated otherwise, in accordance with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.
- 1.2 The accounts have been prepared on the concept of a going concern.

2. INVESTMENTS

2.1 All investments are valued at cost.

3. FIXED ASSETS

- 3.1 Fixed Assets are stated at cost of acquisition inclusive of inward freight, duties and taxes and incidental and direct expenses.
- 3.2 Fixed Assets created out of grants released by Ministry of Corporate Affairs to CCI for the period from 2003 upto March 2009 in the form of non-monetary grants are capitalized at written down value as on 1st April 2009 by corresponding Credit to Capital Fund.

4. DEPRECIATION

- 4.1 Depreciation is provided on written down method as per rates specified in the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- 4.2 In respect of additions to fixed assets during the year, depreciation is considered as per Income Tax Act, 1961.
- 4.3 Assets consisting below Rs. 5000/- are fully depreciated in that year except for library books.

5. GOVERNMENT GRANTS/ SUBSIDIES

- 5.1 Government Grants are accounted on realisation basis and utilisation is accounted on accrual basis.
- 5.2 Unutilised grants including advances paid out of such grants are transferred to the Fund.
- 5.3 Grants received for acquiring office space is shown separately in the Balance Sheet

6. RETIREMENT BENEFITS

- 6.1 CCI has adopted New Pension Scheme (NPS) for its direct/absorbed employees.
- 6.2 The provision for Death Cum Retirement Gratuity is made as per the Actuarial Valuation based on AS 15 (Revised)
- 6.3 In the case of employees who have joined on deputation in CCI, the liability of CCI in the form of Leave Salary and Pension Contribution or Employers' Contribution to Provident Fund, as per Govt, orders pertaining to Foreign Services is being paid by the CCI to the concerned parent offices simultaneously.
- 6.4 The Provision for accumulated leave encashment benefit to the regular employees is made based on the Actuarial Valuation as per AS 15 (Revised)

2. CAPITAL COMMITMENTS:

Estimated value of contracts remaining to be executed on capital account and not provided for (net of advances) are :

- 2.1 The National Buildings Construction Corporation Ltd (NBCC) has allocated 97545 Sq.Ft of Office Space to CCI at their project at East Kidwai Nagar New Delhi. The estimated cost comes to Rs 327 crore and out of this Rs. 129.25 crore was paid to NBCC in 2015-16 and Rs 27.63 crore has been paid in the year 2016-17. The balance amount of Rs 170.12 crore will be paid to NBCC as and when demands are raised by NBCC and grants are released by the Ministry for this purpose.
- 2.2 The National Informatics Centre Services Inc (NICSI) has been assigned with the development of webportal alongwith e-filing module for CCI at a cost of Rs 35.07 lakh. Out of this an amount of Rs 14.03 lakh was paid to NICSI in 2015-16. The balance amount of Rs 21.04 lakh will be paid on completion of the project.

3. CAPITAL WORK IN PROGRESS:

3.1 Building: Ministry of Corporate Affairs released an amount of Rs 129.25 crore as Grants in Aid Capital during the year 2015-16 for payment to M/s National Buildings Construction Corporation Ltd (NBCC) for office space for CCI at their project at East Kidwai Nagar, New Delhi. This amount was paid to NBCC in the year 2015-16. Further, an amount of Rs 27.10 crore was released by the Ministry as Grants in Aid Capital for payment to NBCC in the year 2016-17. Based on the demand of NBCC an amount of Rs 27.63 crore was paid in the year 2016-17. Thus, the total payment made to NBCC comes to Rs 156.88 crore which has been shown under Capital Work in Progress.



3.2 An amount of Rs 14.03 lakh was paid to NICSI during 2015-16 for the development of webportal along with e-filing module for CCI. The amount paid to NICSI has been shown under Capital Work in Progress

4. CURRENT ASSETS:

In the opinion of the Commission, the current assets have a value on realisation in the ordinary course of business equal to the aggregate amount shown in the Balance Sheet.

5. TAXATION:

The Ministry of Finance, Department of Revenue vide notification No. S.O. 530 (E) dated 19th February 2016 under clause (46) of Section 10 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 have exempted Competition Commission of India from paying Income Tax from the year 2016-17 to the year 2020-21.

- 7. An amount of Rs 66,191 /- was realised at the time of disposal of scrap/ condemned assets during the year 2016-17.
- 8. During the year 2015-16, an amount of Rs 24.53 lakh was paid to NICSI for development of e-office software and shown under Capital work in progress. In the year 2016-17, the project was completed and the balance amount of Rs 36.80 lakh was paid to NICSI. Total cost of software development is Rs 61.33 lakh. As the project has been completed, the amount paid during the year 2016-17 and the amount kept under Capital Work in Progress, in this regard has been taken to Fixed Assets under Computer and Peripherals.
- **9.** The Grants-in-Aid released by the Ministry for payment to NBCC for acquiring office space is shown separately in the Balance Sheet under the head Grants-in-Aid for acquiring office space based on the observation made in the Separate Audit Report 2015-16. The Ministry released an amount of

Rs 129.26 crore in 2015-16 and Rs 27.10 crore in 2016-17 as Grants in Aid (Capital) for Office Space. Thus total grants received for this purpose comes to Rs 156.36 crore.

- 10. Competition Commission of India (CCI) is a body corporate established under an Act of Parliament, the Competition Act, 2002 (No.12 of 2003), as amended by the Competition (Amendment) Act, 2007. As per Section 51(1) of the Act, the 'Competition Fund' has been constituted and all Government Grants received by the Commission, the fee received under the Act and interest earned are credited to the Fund.
- 11. Based on the Actuarial Valuation, the liability for Gratuity and Leave Encashment are provided for the year 2016-17. As per valuation the liability for Gratuity is Rs 27,13,860/- and for EL Rs 5,29,539/-. In the case of Half Pay Leave the liability created upto the year 2015-16 is excess and an amount of Rs 8,67,503/- has been reversed from the existing provisions. Hence the net reversal from Leave Encashment provisions comes to Rs 3,37,964/-. After adjusting the payments made (Rs 1,41,518/-) during the year 2016-17 for leave encashment (EL & HPL) net amount of Rs 1,96,446/- has been reversed from the provisions of leave encashment and shown under Schedule XVIII.
- **12.** CCI is following Government of India rules as regards establishment, service matters and other related matters.
- 13. Corresponding figures for the previous year have been regrouped/ rearranged, wherever necessary.
